Key Responsibilities

- 2. Lead and manage the planning, definition, execution, and monitoring of new projects from initiation to closure with Commercial team stakeholders to secure sign-off from management and budget holders.
- 3. Oversee day-to-day project management aspects including coordinating teams, allocating resources, reporting, and ensuring they are completed on time, within scope and budget.
- 4. Develop detailed project plans, schedules and resource allocation plans to ensure timely delivery of project milestones.
- 5. Identify and mitigate project risks and issues.
